November 16, 2026 – April 23, 2027		<u>Celebration of Reconciliation</u> Once the preparation for First Reconciliation is completed, you are welcome to bring your child to experience the Sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time. Your whole family are encouraged to attend. This can be done at either of the Reconciliation services (Monday, 11/16/2026, or Monday, 2/22/2027 both at 6:30pm). Additional priests will be on hand. In addition, you can also contact the parish office and schedule an individual opportunity with one of our priests. We do not recommend celebrating the sacrament for the first time at one of our regularly scheduled times as there are often many penitents which does not allow the priests to be as attentive as your child deserves for the first time.
